The Camp

These are 3 day cricket camps for keen boys and girls. You will be practising, playing, and watching cricket from breakfast to bedtime. You will also experience all the fun of camping out under canvas at Highland Court Cricket Ground.

We shall have approximately 40 children on each camp:

Under II: **Years 4.5.6** Under 14: **Years 7,8,9**

We shall have programmes for both the excellent/outstanding cricketers and those who just love cricket and want to get better. The only essential requirements are

enthusiasm, a desire to improve and have a lot of fun.



Supervision, safety, security

The course will be managed and supervised by an experienced Senior Coach and up to 4 Assistant Coaches. There will also be an Evening Activities Programme run by up to 2 Social Organisers. A team of volunteer parents will supervise the cooking, sleeping and washing arrangements. Please offer to help if you can!

Highland Court Cricket Ground is a secluded, safe and responsible site for this event. However, every sensible security precaution will be taken, including a Night Watchman.

The Programme

- Under II: Arrive: 10.00am, Wednesday 7th August Depart: 4.00pm, Friday 9th August
 - Under 14: Arrive: 10.00am, Monday 12 August Depart: 4.00pm, Wednesday 14 August
- Cricket coaching will cover all the skills of fielding, bowling, batting, wicket keeping and captaining, as well as the mental approach.
- There will be practice matches, competitions and a set of stretching personal Cricket Standards for each child to achieve, relative to their ability.
- Coaches will use a whole range of coaching techniques and equipment. including small group and individual coaching, demonstrations and clinics by visiting experts and "stars," video feedback, a bowling machine, nets,
- around camping and include BBQs, camp fires and sing songs.
- practice "in the middle" etc. The social programme will be organised



The camp will run whatever the weather, as we shall have various wet weather activities.

Sleeping, eating and camping

- This is a cricket camp so the children will do as much of the camping as practical (e.g. collecting firewood and washing up!) whilst having maximum time to improve cricketing skills.
- Children are encouraged to bring their own tents and share with friends/ family. There will be a central marquee(s) for those who don't bring or don't want to bring a tent. <u>BUT</u> each child <u>must</u> bring their own mattress/camp bed, ground sheet, sleeping bag/blankets and pillow.
- A detailed "Kit List" will be sent to each child on Application.
- There is hot and cold water and showers and separate W.C. facilities for boys and girls.
- There will be separate sleeping areas for girls and boys.
- The team of parents will ensure that each child enjoys a healthy and balanced diet and plenty of fluids.

Fees

- I. £105 per child per camp, all inclusive.
- Fees include all the cricket coaching, facilities, social activities, all food and refreshments and use of all facilities at Highland Court Cricket Ground.
- There will be concessions available for parents who help run the camp and a 10% discount for St. Lawrence & Highland Court Cricket Club Members.

There are no concessions if children do not stay overnight. Non-campers will be discouraged.

All fees are payable in advance.




